Adult Forum Facilitator Position Description

The primary role of an Adult Forum Facilitator is to lead/facilitate the pre-determined lesson(s) to an adult audience as part of LUMC's Adult Ministries mission: to provide a wide variety of experiences intended to meet people at a variety of places on their faith journey to help them grow and mature as followers of Jesus. The lesson or series of lessons are determined in consultation with the Adult Ministries Coordinator and may include a Bible study, book study or current events with discussion of how they relate to Christian faith.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Consult with the Adult Ministries Coordinator as needed for programming content and guidance in presenting lesson content.
2. Prepare for the lesson ahead of time including gathering pertinent materials to share with Adult Forum attendees.
3. Provide a safe, welcoming, inclusive and positive environment for interactive discussion.
4. Lead the lesson and actively involve others in reading scripture and participating in discussion.
5. Start the lesson on time and end on time.
6. Be trained in Safe Sanctuaries policies of the Upper NY Conference and of Lansing United Methodist Church, and covenant with LUMC to fully carry out those policies.
7. Attend periodic review of Lansing United Methodist Church Safe Sanctuary policies and procedures as they apply to its Adult Christian Education ministries.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A personal commitment to Jesus' teaching to love God and one another, a growing faith journey, and a willingness to share their faith with other adults.
2. Positive interpersonal skills interacting with adults. Ability to listen and help others discuss their faith, as well as to connect to God and one another.
3. Be at least 18 years of age.
4. Ability to adapt lesson content in the moment to allow for meaningful group discussion.
